Enclosed you will find your National Airedale Rescue Home Again Microchips.

Each cellophane package includes:

- sterile packaged syringe with microchip
- 4 stickers with the microchip scan number on them
- 1 rubber tag with the microchip number (and ring for attaching)
- 1 file card
- 1 blue and white Registration Form

The cellophane package is open at one end (the plunger end of the package) and resealed. This is because a sticker has to be put on each Registration Sheet that shows "Airedale Terrier Rescue" as the Shelter that is providing you with the microchip.

We request the following from you in exchange for the provided microchips:

- That you are diligent about registering the microchips
- That you request that your vet implant the microchip at no charge during the vet exam and routine shots visit
- Enclosed is a letter from the Board requesting that your vet implant the chip at no charge (copy and distribute with the chips, as necessary).
- That you do not lose track of the provided microchips
- That you request a new supply when you get down to your next to last available microchip
- That you submit the names of the Airedales and the number of the microchip to Rusty LaFrance, for the batch you received,

before another batch can be shipped to you. (There is a Master MicroChip data base being kept that will be accessible to the Directors)

We suggest the following:

- There are 4 sticky numbers on the card.
- - you can use one for your file
- one for your vet's file
- - one for the new adopter
- and one can be used to stick on the attached sheet for reminding you to submit the required information (via email) to Rusty LaFrance

If you would like to make a donation, from your adoption fee, to National Airedale Rescue to help continue this program, we would gladly accept and suggest \$10 per microchip kit.

These chips are provided to you at no cost for identification of rescued Airedales only. If you wish to purchase the chips for some other use (like your personal dogs), please make your check payable to National Airedale Rescue for \$15 per microchip kit.

Please mark the Memo Line of your check with "Microchip Program" so that it can be properly accounted for against the cost of the program.
